Huntington Beach, CA – Camburg Engineering in their #7275 Ford Ranger Edge finished the year 5 points out of the 1st place championship in Best in the Desert's Mini TT 7200 class. A few rule changes this year opened up the class and made for some very fast and exciting racing start to finish.
